SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT

The intent of this local law is to provide a modification in the erm of Civil Service administration by withdrawing from the present Civil Service Commission form and electing the Personnel Officer form as described in Section 15 of the Civil Service Law and pursuant to the method for changing the form of Civil Service administration as provided in Section 16 of the Civil Service Law.

SECTION 2.

Commencing January 1., 1985, there shall be established the position of Personnel Officer, which shall combine in one position responsibility to performing the duties currently being performed by the Personnel Director and the Civil Service Commission. The present Personnel Department and the resent Civil Service Commission shall be combined into one department to be designated as the Steuben County Department of Personnel and Civil Service. The present positions of Personnel Director and Commissioners of Civil Service shall be abolished and all other permanent competitive positions in the Personnel


Department and the Civil Service Commission to remain as heretofore established, to wit: Senior Personnel Technician, Senior Personnel Clerk,

Personnel Clerk, Senior Typist, and Typist. Said other permanent competitive positions shall be transferred to the newly created Steuben County Department of Personnel and Civil Service.

The Personnel Officer shall be appointed by this Board of Supervisors for a six-year (6) term as required by Section 15.1.(b) of the Civil Service Law, which term of office shall commence on January 1, 1985.
