SECTION\_3. The County Treasurer, upon adoption of the within Local Law No. Two for the Year 1986, be and the same, hereby is directed to appropriate funds sufficient from the Contingent Account to the appropriate line items for the expense incurred including wages and associated fringe benefits.

SECTION\_4. This local law shall become effective, subject to a permissive referendum, forty-five (45) days after the date of its final adoption and on the date it is duly filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York and in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.
