

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
COUNTY OF STEUBEN**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Steuben County Legislature will hold a public hearing at the Steuben County Legislative Chambers, 3 East Pulteney Square in the Village of Bath, New York on the 24th day of July 2017, at 10:00 a.m. for the purpose of hearing public comments on the community development needs of Steuben County and to discuss the possible submission of one or more Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) applications for the 2017 program year. The CDBG program is administered by the New York State Office of Community Renewal (OCR), and will make available to eligible local governments approximately \$45 Million for the 2017 program year for housing, economic development, public facilities, public infrastructure, and planning activities, with the principal purpose of benefitting low/moderate income persons. The hearing will provide further information about the CDBG program and will also for citizen participation in the development of any proposed grant applications and/or to provide technical assistance to develop alternative proposals. Comments on the CDBG program or proposed project(s) will be received at this time. The hearing is being conducted pursuant to Section 570.486, Subpart I of the CFR and in compliance with the requirements of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1974, as amended.

The Legislature Chambers are accessible to persons with disabilities. If special accommodations are needed for persons with disabilities, those with hearing impairments, or those in need of translation from English, those individuals should contact the Clerk of the Legislature's Office at 607-664-2247 at least one week in advance of the hearing date to allow for necessary arrangements.
