SECTION 1. The Chairman of the Steuben County Legislature be, and the same hereby is, authorized and directed for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), and payment of advertising costs, to convey to Wheeler W. and Eleanor Meyers, the following tract of land:

ALL THAT TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND located in the Town of Bath, Steuben County, New York, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a concrete marker in the Northwesterly corner of a lot now owned by Wheeler and Eleanor Meyers said concrete marker being the corner pin of Meyers property and the existing Right-of-Way for the existing CR415.

Thence along a line South 58 degrees 21 minutes West a distance of 110.00 more or less feet to a point on the Easterly edge of an existing driveway.

Thence Southerly along the Easterly edge of the existing drive a distance of 183.90 to a point.

Thence North 58 degrees 04 minutes East of 109.00 more or less feet to an iron pin at the Southwesterly corner of said lands owned by Wheeler and Eleanor Meyers.

Thence North 8 degrees 20 minutes West a distance of 183.75 feet long the Westerly property line of said lands owned by Wheeler and Eleanor Meyers to the point of beginning.

Subject to all Right-of-Way and or easements of record.

Being a portion of premises conveyed to the New York Department of Pubic Works on map 39 SH5224 and filed in the Steuben County Clerk's Office on January 29, 1951.

SECTION 2. The within statute shall be construed as an offer to convey to, and an option to purchase the subject premise, by Wheeler W. and Eleanor Meyers. Failure or refusal to furnish consideration on or before August 31, 1991 shall terminate the within offer.

This local law shall become effective subject to a permissive referendum, forty-five (45) days after the date of its final adoption and on the date it is duly filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of New York and in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.




