of STEUBEN as follows:

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intention of the Legislature by this Local Law to establish the term of office of County Legislators as four (4) years and to stagger the election of its membership between odd numbered years for terms commencing in even numbered years. It is intended to amend Local Law No. One of the Year 1983, Section 3, but no other provision of that Local Law.

SECTION 2. TERM OF OFFICE. County Legislators shall be elected at general elections held in odd numbered years.

(a) In General. County Legislators shall be elected at general elections held in odd numbered years. The term of office shall be four (4) years, dating from January first of the year next succeeding such general election, the first such election to be held at the time of the general election in November, 1995.

(b) Staggered term of office. Seats on the Legislature represented by the following nine (9) legislative candidates shall have a four (4) year term of office commencing January 1, 1996 and terminating December 31, 1999, and each four years thereafter; to wit, the seats for candidates receiving the highest number of votes in the November, 1995 election in districts 1, City of Hornell, 2, City of Corning, 3, Town of Bath, 13, Towns of Caton, Corning and Hornby, as well as the seats for districts 4, Towns of Cohocton and Wayland, 6, Towns of Dansville, Hartsville and Hornellsville, 7, Towns of Avoca, Fremont, Howard, and Wheeler, 8, Towns of Bradford, Campbell and Wayne and 11, Towns of Addison, Lindley and Tuscarora.

Seats on the Legislature represented by the successful candidates in districts 1, City of Hornell, 2, City of Corning, 3, Town of Bath and 13, Town of Caton, Corning and Hornby receiving the lesser number of votes in the November, 1995 election and districts 5, Towns of Prattsburgh, Pulteney and Urbana, 9, Towns of Cameron, Canisteo and Thurston, 10, Towns of Greenwood, Jasper and Rathbone and 12, Town of Erwin shall have a two (2) year term of office commencing January 1, 1996 and terminating December 31, 1997; thereafter those seats on the Legislature shall have a four (4) year term of office commencing January 1, 1998 and terminating December 31, 2001, and every four (4) years thereafter.

(c) Terms of County Officers. Those County Officers having terms, by provision of law, coterminous with terms of office of the members of the Legislature shall be deemed to commence January 1, 1996 and terminate December 31, 1999 and each four (4) years thereafter.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Local Law shall become effective only if approved by the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors voting upon the Local Law at the general election to be held in November, 1994. If so approved, it shall become effective immediately.




