A local law Authorizing the Sale of Certain Property Owned by

SECTION 1. The Chairman of the Steuben County Legislature be, and the same hereby is, authorized and directed for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) to convey to Julius Hauser and Jadwiga Hauser the following tract of land:

ALL THAT TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND, being a portion of Great Lot 34 in Township 4 of the fifth Range of Townships, situated in the Town of Fremont, County of Steuben, State of New York bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at a point in the center of County Route 70-A at a distance of 1295.2 ± feet measured westerly along the center of County Route 70-A from its intersection with the center of the Hungry Hollow Town Road;

Thence S02°16'04"W along the division line between the properties of the Steuben County Welfare Department, now or formerly, (L.602, Pg. 314) and Ellis (L.1117, Pg. 348) in part, and the County of Steuben by virtue of Map #6.20 (L.415, Pg. 327) and Ellis (L.1117. Pg. 348) in part, a distance of 194.40 feet to an iron pin set at the point of beginning of the parcel to be conveyed;

Thence S02° 16'04"W a distance of 80.31 feet to an iron pin;
Thence N89°23'52"W a distance of 1025.01 feet to an iron pin;
Thence N02°16'04"E a distance of 85.39 feet to an iron pin;
Thence S89°02'51"E a distance of 751.48 feet to an iron pin;
Thence S89°17'45"E a distance of 273.40 feet to the point of beginning.

The above described parcel contains 84,437 square feet or 1.938 acres more or less.

Intending to convey by this description the lands acquired by the County of Steuben by the following:

[A] Acquisition Map #6.20 acquired from Fred Windsor and Ola M. Windsor by deed dated May 8, 1930 and recorded in Steuben County Clerk's Office in Liber 415 of deeds at Page 327.

SECTION 2. The within statute shall be construed as an offer to convey to, and option to purchase the subject premise, by Julius Hauser and Jadwiga Hauser. Failure or refusal to furnish consideration on or before August 24, 1998 shall terminate the within offer.

SECTION 3. This local law shall become effective subject to a permissive referendum, forty-five (45) days after the date of its final adoption and on the date it is duly filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of New York and in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.




