of STEUBEN as follows:

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT

It is the intent of the Steuben County Legislature to amend the weight of the vote of each Legislator to comply with the population as reflected by the 2000 Census.

SECTION 2. SECTION 6 of Local Law No. One for the Year 1983, as previously amended by Local Law No. Five for the Year 1993, relating to the membership and composition of the Legislature of the County of Steuben is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 6. VOTING STRENGTH

The apportionment of the voting strength of the members of the Legislature of the County of Steuben shall be determined by the 2000 Federal Census in the County of Steuben, until the next decennial federal census, in which event the voting strength shall be changed, if necessary, to conform to such decennial federal census. On the effective date, each Legislator elected within the respective Districts of the County of Steuben shall be entitled to the following vote on any resolution, local law, motion or proposal to be voted upon by the Legislature, to wit:


