Special Needs


Each provider is focused on meeting your needs. Each provider has transportation for those in wheelchairs.

Safety

Take your seat as quickly as possible. Never change seats while the bus is moving. Wait until the bus departs your stop before crossing the street. Refrain from engaging in unnecessary conversation with the driver. No pets, except service animals.

Lost & Found

Items lost on the bus may be picked up from your provider by contacting your provider. Transportation providers are not responsible for items left on buses.

Route and Stop Announcements:

The Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA) requires public transit to make announcements of all time points and transfer points.

Public Transit Terms:

Accessible Vehicles: Transit passenger vehicles that give access and seating to passengers with disabilities, including wheelchair users.

Dial-A-Ride/Demand Response: Non-fixed-route service utilizing vans or buses with passengers boarding and exiting at pre-arranged times at any location within the system's service area. Riders must meet certain criteria.

Fare: Amount of money that is required each time you board the bus to pay for one trip from one location to another. When using cash, exact change is required. Also, you may purchase tokens or monthly passes that can be used for unlimited rides on the system.

Fixed Route: Service provided on a repetitive, fixed-schedule basis along a specific route with vehicles stopping to pick up and deliver passengers to specific locations; each fixed-route trip serves the same origins and destinations, unlike Demand Response and taxicabs.

Flag Stop System: A passenger may board a bus at any safe place along a fixed route. When you see the bus you want, signal the driver by waving.

On Request (OR): Locations with On Request service are notated on the bus schedule. Riders can direct their request to the bus operator or call ahead to arrange.

Route Deviation: A fixed-route transit service that will deviate 3/4 of a mile from its normal route for prearranged pick-ups. There is an additional cost for the service. Route Deviation is not available on express/commuter routes. Call ahead to arrange.

Travel Training: Individualized training that gives riders the skills to travel safely & independently on public transportation.

Alternative Transportation

Volunteer Driver Programs:

Steuben Coordinated Transportation - Volunteer Program: Provides transportation assessment, information and referral through 2-1-1 for all residents. Regional transportation services through volunteer drivers for non-emergency medical and nutritional appointments for residents of Steuben County aged 60 and over and for transportation disadvantaged residents.

Medical Answering Services: Provides non-emergency transposition, or reimbursement for transportation to & from medical appointments. Must be a recipient of Medicaid, and call at least 1-2 weeks before appointment.

Project Care: Sponsored by the Steuben County Office for the Aging (SCOFA). Provides limited, non-emergency, local transportation to individuals 60 or older that reside in the towns of Avoca, Bath, Bradford, Hammansport, Pulteney, Prattsburgh, Savona, or Wayne. (607) 664-2298

Faith in Action of the Greater Steuben Area: Provides non-emergency transportation to seniors for medical appointments and routine errands. Must be 60 or older and able to transfer themselves from wheelchair into vehicle. (607) 324-1138 / (607) 936-0941

VA Medical Center Bath: Must be a veteran & enrolled in a health program at the VA Health Care Facility.



To schedule a Route Deviation trip, call our Customer Service Department at (607) 734-5211 between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. For next day service, your request must be made by 5:00 p.m. the previous day. Route Deviation is not provided to the following commuter routes: #10, #20 and #30X.

Suggestions or Complaints / Title VI Civil Rights Act:

Senior Medicare Fare Programs / Persons with a Disability:

Riders who have a disability, who are 60 years of age or older (Senior Citizen), or who hold a Medicare card, can ride for half the regular fare on regular route service and/ or Route Deviation/Demand Response Service. For a rider with a disability, a Half Fare I.D. Card may be purchased at the C TRAN office. Persons with qualifying Half Fare cards must show proof each time you board. *On Mondays, Senior Citizens ride free with the proof of age.*

Dial A Ride: Individuals on Medicaid may qualify for transportation to and from medical appointments. Call 734-5211 for more information.
