Emerging Drug Trends

"Krokodil" - A synthetic form of a heroin-like drug that is made by mixing codeine tablets with various toxic chemicals including, lighter fluid and industrial cleaners. It has a similar effect as heroin does to the brain. It eats away at flesh which usually becomes gangrenous, possibly resulting in an amputation.

"N-Bomb" - Refers to any of the three related synthetic hallucinogens (25I-NBOMe, 25C-NBOMe, and 25B-NBOMe) that are being sold as legal substitutes for LSD or mescaline. Also called "legal acid", "smiles," or "25I". They can be found in powder or liquids, soaked into blotter paper (LSD) or laced with something edible. Extremely small amounts can cause seizures, heart attack or arrested breathing and death.

"Molly" - Is a pure crystalline powder form of the club drug known as MDMA. It produces energy, euphoria, and may affect body temperature and cause confusion, depression and sleep problems. Users may "seek out Molly" to avoid substitutes known to be commonly found in pills sold as ecstasy, such as caffeine, methamphetamine, and other harmful drugs.

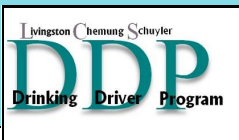

PITTSBURGH— The Allegheny County Medical Examiner's Office has issued an alert to the public after three overdose deaths over the past two days. According to the medical examiner's office, a particularly strong form of heroin may be to blame. Officials say the three overdose deaths have happened within the last 48 hours in three different neighborhoods. In each case, the medical examiner's office reports multiple stamp bags were found at the scene, including bags labeled "Theraflu." Investigators are awaiting the results of definitive testing.
